Call for Applications: 1-3 month fellowships for research in Germany

The Max Weber Stiftung – Georgia Branch Office supports further development of exchange and cooperation in the broader field of history and related disciplines between the scientific communities of the South Caucasus and Germany. To this end, we are offering one to three-month scholarships for historical research in German archives, libraries and research institutions for the period from 1 July to 31 December 2024

Applicants are PhD-students or hold a PhD. They are affiliated to an institution in the South Caucasian countries. They work on a topic that corresponds to the research profile of the Georgia Branch Office (<https://mwsgeorgia.hypotheses.org/2>).

The scholarship is intended to cover the additional expenses resulting from the research stay in Germany. The amount of the scholarship is determined by the Georgia Office and is based on the DFG guidelines.

The detailed guidelines of the Max Weber Foundation – Georgia Branch Office for the award and the amount of the scholarship are regulated in detail in the Scholarship Regulations of the Max Weber Network Eastern Europe.

In addition to the informal letter of application the following documents must be submitted:

- Exposé on the research project including information on the status of the preliminary work (approx. 2 pages)
- Outline of the research work that makes the stay in Germany necessary, including planned duration of stay + working plan for corresponding archives/libraries/institutions
- Brief assessment by the academic supervisor (or another expert in the relevant field) (up to one page)
- Curriculum vitae (with list of publications)

- Copy of the Master's or doctoral degree certificate
- In case of research stays in German institutions: confirmation by the given institution
